Write/Edit/Design (Ongoing)

- Write engaging news articles that tell the story of our agency (programs, impacts, events, personal profiles) and the community we serve. Provide content for DM/SM to share on agency and external sites.
- Monitor a variety of sources to track issues that affect our constituents (new business, community resources, community events, human interest...), and report on them. May involve personal interviews.
- Design and publish weekly South Lansing e-newsletter and bi-annual 8 page printed newsletter.
- Work with staff to design press releases, educational materials, event flyers/posters, and annual report.

Digital Marketing & Social Media (Ongoing)

- Update our website, google calendar, and social media pages daily with content from staff and W/E/D.
- Share content to and from 60+ external social media sites and online community calendars. Forward leads for potential community stories to W/E/D.
- Provide guidance for updating our online marketing strategy to enhance brand awareness and increase audience reach. Boost posts as directed. Monitor analytics to track reach.

Public Health & Wellness (Ongoing)

- Teach local youth, adults, and families in a variety of settings about gardening, nutrition, healthy recipes, etc.
- Work with staff to secure venues, schedule classes, recruit participants, plan lessons, and conduct workshops.
- Show community members the connection between nutrition, exercise, and health outcomes.

Urban Agriculture (April- October)

- Assist Americorps Food Access Coordinator with all aspects of organic food production in our passive solar hoop house and community garden plots, from seed starting through harvest.
- May include structural maintenance and repair of the hoop house, as needed.
- Must be physically able to harvest and distribute produce to local food pantries and refugee communities.

Farmers Market (April – October)

- Assist Market Manager with planning, coordinating, and promoting our weekly farmers market (Thursdays 3-7).
- Includes recruiting, scheduling, and tracking vendors, volunteers, entertainers, and featured guests.
- Meticulous attention to detail required for financial transactions (credit card/EBT) and sales reports.
- Must be physically able to assist with set up and tear down canopies, tables, and chairs.

Fund Development (Ongoing)

- Research government/foundation grants and potential sponsors/donors.
- Monitor grant request and award timelines, maintain donor database, and track response status.
- Assist staff with compiling data, preparing grant proposals, writing donor appeals and thank you letters.

Outreach and Engagement (Ongoing, some evenings required)

- Represent SLCDA at neighborhood/community meetings, events, forums, workshops, etc., to promote agency programs and initiatives, distribute flyers or other materials, and recruit participants/volunteers.
- Gather feedback (interviews, surveys, etc.) about issues affecting the community.
- Must be culturally aware, courteous, and professional at all times.

Community/Economic Development (Ongoing)

- Work with staff to support grass-roots community organizing and redevelopment initiatives in targeted areas
- Analyze data and create reports on various community indicators e.g., food equity, poverty rates, health
 outcomes, land use, available resources, access to medical care.
